

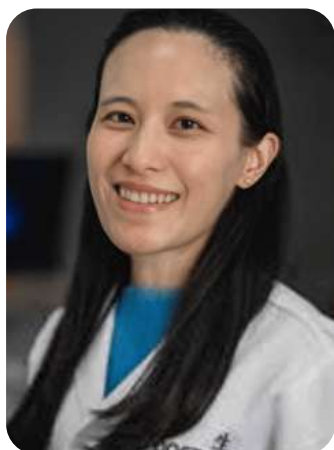

- Abstract Submission Deadline: 30th June 2025
- Early Bird Registration Deadline: 30th March 2025

Submission Guidelines:

- Abstracts must be submitted in English to <https://5thasfpcongress.com/abstract-submission/>
- Submissions must not have been published previously.
- There is no limit to the number of abstracts per participant.
- Case reports are accepted.
- Abstracts must not exceed 350 words (excluding title, authors, affiliations, and section headings).
- The abstract should follow the structure: Introduction, Objectives, Methodology, Results, and Conclusion.
- Figures, tables, pictures, and references should not be included.

Notification & Presentation:

- Authors will be notified of acceptance within three (3) working days via email.
- Accepted presenters must confirm their conference registration for their abstracts to be included in the programme.
- E-posters will be displayed throughout the conference.

Awardees will also receive an e-certificate for the Best Poster Award. Failure to submit an e-poster by the deadline will result in disqualification.
